

Iowa Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association's COVID-19 Horsemen Assistance Program & Policy

Goal:

The Covid-19 Assistance Program has been created by the Iowa HBPA to help trainers cover expenses they have incurred during the COVID-19 pandemic while moving to Prairie Meadows.

Policy Requirements:

- The program is for IA HBPA members only
- Licensed Trainer or Trainer/Owner only members may apply for assistance
- Applicants shall apply for assistance based solely on the number of Thoroughbreds that are currently stalled at Prairie Meadows and pony horses shall not count
- All applicants must have the "Covid-19 Horsemen Assistance Form" completed and returned to the IA HBPA office no later than June 30th at 3:00 pm
- The number of stalled Thoroughbreds indicated for assistance will be verified with Prairie Meadows
- All applications will be vetted for accuracy and may receive up to \$100 per stalled Thoroughbred at Prairie Meadows once verification is completed
